GENERAL LAWS

GOVERNMENT OF UTTAR PRADESH -UTTAR PRADESH LIFT AND ESCALATOR ACT, 2024

Applicability:

Applicable to all owners intending to install new lifts or escalators, existing installations requiring registration, manufacturers, installation agencies, and those involved in maintenance contracts in Uttar Pradesh.

The Uttar Pradesh Lifts and Escalators Act, 2024, (U.P. Act No. 4 of 2024), has been enacted to regulate the construction, installation, maintenance, and safe operation of lifts and escalators in the state. Key compliance aspects of the Act include:

- Owners must register lifts and escalators before installation.
- Inform authorities upon commissioning and pay the fee.
- Ensure monthly maintenance by authorized personnel and submit annual AMC details (except private premises).
- Address technical faults immediately and display "NOT IN USE" until resolved.
- Maintain a maintenance logbook and conduct biannual mock drills in public premises.
- Install automatic rescue devices and ensure proper lighting, communication, and emergency instructions inside lifts.
- Install CCTV cameras in lifts located in public premises.
- Obtain insurance for public premises to cover accidents (except government premises).
- Adhere to relevant building and safety codes.
- Ensure accessibility in public premises for disabled individuals.
- Registration valid for the manufacturer's specified life span; reregister for alterations or shifting.
- Register existing lifts/escalators within six months and complete modifications within thirty months.
- Manufacturers and service providers must register and comply with the Act.
- Report accidents to authorities within 24 hours and follow proper investigation protocols.
- Provide financial compensation as prescribed by the Government for accidents.
- Authorities can inspect and require rectifications for noncompliance in public premises.

GENERAL LAWS

- Suspend operations immediately if safety is endangered.
- All dues recoverable as land revenue, with late fees for delays.
- Officers are protected for actions done in good faith under this Act.
- Serve notices by post, electronic mode, or direct delivery.
- Appeals against orders to be made to Divisional Commissioners or designated officers.
- Provisions apply with modifications to government or semigovernment premises.
- The State Government can create rules and grant exemptions with justification.
